PERSONAL PRONOUNS (PRONOMBRES PERSONALES)

I/ YO first person singular/primera persona del singular

TU/ YOU second person singular/ segunda persona del singular

ÉL/ HE third person singular / tercera persona del singular

ELLA/SHE third person singular / tercera persona del singular

NOSOTROS/WE first person plural / primera persona del plural

USTEDES/ YOU second person plural / segunda persona del plural

ELLOS/THEY third person plural / tercera persona del plural



ELLO/ IT third person singular (neuter) / tercera persona del singular es neutro



SENTENCES SIMPLES / EN FUNCIÓN DE SUJETO

EXAMPLE:

1. I AM ILL / ESTOY ENFERMO
2. YOU ARE TALL / TU ERES ALTO
3. HE IS HANDSOME / EL ES GUAPO
4. SHE IS PRETTY / ELLA ES BONITA
5. WE ARE TIRED / NOSOTROS ESTAMOS CANSADOS
6. YOU ARE ANGRY / USTEDES TIENEN HAMBRE
7. THEY ARE AT THE CINEMA / ELLOS VAN AL CINE
8. IT IS COLD TODAY / HACE FRÍO HOY

Affirmative Form (+) / forma de afirmativo

Personal Pronouns Verb to be Contractions

Personal Pronouns	Verb to be	Contractions
I	Am	I'm
You	Are	You're
He	Is	He's
She	Is	She's
It	Is	It's
We	Are	We're
You	Are	You're
They	Are	They're

Example:

1. I'm Gabriel / yo soy Gabriel
2. You are Luis / Tu eres Luis
3. He's tired / El esta cansado
4. She is pretty / Ella es bonita
5. It's cold / Esta frio
6. We are the champions / nosotros somos los campeones
7. They are tall / ellos son Altos

Negative form (-) / forma negativa o negar

Personal Pronouns	Verb to be	Negation	Contractions
I	Am	Not	I'm not
You	Are	Not	You're not or You aren't
He	Is	Not	He's not o He isn't
She	Is	Not	She's not o She isn't
It	Is	Not	It's not o It isn't
We	Are	Not	We're not o We aren't
You	Are	Not	You're not o You aren't

They	Are	Not	They're not o They aren't
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Note: In the first person singular (I) there is only one form of contraction

Example:

I'm not Pedro, I am Gabriel / No soy Pedro, Yo soy Gabriel

You aren't here / no estas aquí

He's not tall / el no esta alto

She isn't happy / ella no esta feliz

It isn't red / no es Rojo

We're not angry / nosotros no estamos enojados

They aren't working / no están trabajando

Interrogative Form (?) forma de preguntar

Am I... ?

Are You ... ?

Is he ... ?

Is she ... ?

Is it ... ?

Are we ... ?

Are They ... ?

Note: It is necessary to add a complement (predicate) to have a complete question.

Example:

Am I a ridiculous? / ¿Soy un ridículo?

Are You Carol? / ¿Tu eres Carol?

Is he a mechanic? / ¿El es mecanico?

Is she the Little Polly? / ¿es ella la pequeña Polly?

Is it a car Green? / ¿Es un coche verde?



Are We faster? / ¿somos mas rapidos?

Are they married? / ¿ellos están casados?
